As we begin a new athletic season at Bishop Leonard - St Mary of the Mount Academy, let us continue to build on a solid foundation of good sportsmanship, positive attitude and open communication.

Our mission here at B.L.S.M.M.A. is to educate and prepare all students to become active, contributing members of the church community by providing a challenging, caring, and nurturing atmosphere. We daily strive to foster in the mind of the child a sense of personal dignity and worth, as well as a respect for the uniqueness of others.

Athletics is an extension of the school program. All school Athletic Programs are to be viewed as part of the school curriculum. As a result, the principal is responsible for the conduct of the coaches, players and the spectators.

This code of conduct is a necessary policy that holds everyone (students and Parents) accountable for his or her actions and to keep B.L.S.M.M.A. members in good standing both in and around the community.

Each offence is treated differently, depending on the severity. The Athletic Association will hear the complaint and discuss the consequences at the monthly meeting. The principal will have the final say in the outcome.

This is your First and Only warning! Please review the following with your children and go over the expected behavior for all Bishop Leonard - St Mary of the Mount sports functions.

The following are prohibited:

- Using vulgar language.
- Using vulgar language and / name - calling directed at coaching staff and / or the referee.
- Using vulgar language towards opposing teams coaching staff and players.
- Destruction / vandalism if B.L.S.M.M.A. school property or host facility property. (i.e. locker rooms, rest rooms, gymnasium, parking lot, etc).
- Inappropriate / disrespectful behavior of parent(s) / guardian(s) during and after games or events.
- Players who walk off the court during a game.
- Players repeatedly missing practice / games with out contacting the coach.
- Using weapons and or equipment to purposely injure another player, coach, fan or person while part of a team.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct of any kind in a Bishop Leonard - St Mary of the Mount Academy / Athletic Association sponsored activity.
